Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

EU4Health Programme: 2024 new calls for proposals

The European Health and Digital Executive Agency (HaDEA) has published new calls for proposals on cancer, mental health, health promotion and disease prevention, and the use of AI in health, under the EU4Health Annual Work Programme 2024, with the following topics:

- EU4H-2024-PJ-03-1: Supporting a comprehensive, prevention-oriented approach to mental health in the Union;

- [EU4H-2024-PJ-03-2](#): Health promotion and prevention of non-communicable and communicable diseases;
- [EU4H-2024-PJ-03-3](#): Radiation safety and quality of computed tomography imaging of children and young adults;
- [EU4H-2024-PJ-03-4](#): Personalised Cancer Medicine;
- [EU4H-2024-PJ-03-5](#): Supporting the establishment of new networks of expertise on cancer and cancer conditions;
- [EU4H-2024-PJ-03-6](#): Advancing the adoption of artificial intelligence in health;
- [EU4H-2024-PJ-03-7](#): Action grants for the organisation of conference and events.

Creative Europe Programme: Media Strand calls for proposals 2025

Creative Europe launched 6 new calls for proposals 2025 for its second strand (Media Strand) dedicated to promoting the competitiveness, scalability, cooperation, innovation, and sustainability in the European audio-visual sector. The calls comprise both project and lump sum grants. Total budget: 81.500.000 €.

Funding programme: Creative Europe Programme

Call & Topic ID: CREA-MEDIA-2025

Deadline: between December 2024 and April 2025 (depending on the topic)

Applicants: legal entities established in EU Member States or Creative Europe associated countries

Activity sector: media

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities, each established in different Member States or Creative Europe associated countries)

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell’ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

EIT Food: Fast Track to Market 2024

This call aims at accelerating the commercialisation of food products and services in Europe contributing to positive change in the food system. With up to 250.000€/beneficiary, supplied via a revenue-based financing mechanism, it will fund mature start-ups and SMEs whose products or services directly contribute to one of EIT Food’s three missions:

- [A Net Zero Food System](#);
- [A Fully Transparent, Fair and Resilient Food System](#).

Deadline: November 26th 2024

Applicants: start-ups and SMEs established in EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries

Activity sector: food system innovation

Partnership: not required

EIT Urban Mobility: SME Market Expansion Open Call 2025

This call aims at supporting SMEs that offer solutions (minimum TRL 7) to key providers within the urban mobility ecosystem (e.g. city authorities, passenger transport operators, logistics and mobility providers, energy companies, the police and security services). The applicants can present new product/service

for an existing client or significantly improve an existing product/service for expansion into a geographical region or sector. Total call budget: 892.500€; up to 59.500€/beneficiary.

Deadline: December 2nd 2024

Applicants: SMEs established in EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries

Activity sector: urban mobility

Partnership: not required

Connecting Europe Facility: Cross-border renewable energy projects

The European Climate, Infrastructure, and Environment Executive Agency (CINEA) has published a new call for proposals within the energy sector of the Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) programme. The aim is to promote cross-border cooperation between Member States in the fields of planning, development, and the cost-effective exploitation of renewable energy sources and facilitate their integration through energy storage facilities.

The call includes 2 topics – works and studies – for a total budget of 80.000.000€.
