CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 21-27. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche call for proposals pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Single Market programme: European Social Economy Missions

This call for proposals will support consortia developing collaboration through sharing and replicating best practices and learning with focus on boosting the resilience, the greening and the digitalisation of social economy enterprises and SMEs active in rural areas. Available budget: €1.000.000; number of projects to be funded: max 4.

Funding programme: Single Market Programme – COSME

Call & Topic ID: SMP-COSME-2023-RESILIENCE-01

Deadline: December 7th 2023

Applicants: legal entities (public or private bodies) established in EU Member States or SMP associated

countries

Activity sector: social economy;

Partnership: required (consortia of minimum 4 and up to around 10 applicants, including: a) at least three regional or local public governments; b) at least one business related organisation; c) additional applicants can be other economic operators such as SMEs, social economy organisations or enterprises, cooperatives, NGOs, civil society organisations

Creative Europe Programme: European Cooperation Projects 2024

This action supports projects involving organisations in the cultural and creative sectors of all sizes, including micro-organisations and small-sized organisations, and from different countries to undertake sectoral or cross-sectoral activities. Total budget: 59.730.025 euro. The call includes 2 topics:

- CREA-CULT-2024-COOP-1 - Small-scale projects (grant up to 200.000 €)

- CREA-CULT-2024-COOP-2 - Medium-scale projects (grant up to 1.000.000 €)

Funding programme: Creative Europe Programme – Culture Strand

Call & Topic ID: European Cooperation projects (CREA-CULT-2024-COOP)

Deadline: January 23rd 2024

Applicants: Cultural and creative organisations, cinemas, films **Activity sector:** music, publishing, cultural heritage and architecture

Partnership: required (min 3 entities from 3 different countries for small scale projects)

<u>Horizon Europe: Circular solutions for textile value chains through innovative sorting, recycling,</u> and design for recycling (Research and Innovation Action)

The topic aims at improved management of the end-of-life phase of textile products. Proposals should address one or more of the following subjects and aim to combine them where relevant in a systemic way: facilitation of the disintegration of textile products through design, sorting, and recycling of textiles. The targeted TRL at the end of the projects is 5 to 6. Total call budget: 15 million €; indicative number of grants: 3.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe, Cluster 6 – Climate, Energy and Mobility

Call & Topic ID: Circular economy and bioeconomy sectors (HORIZON-CL6-2024-CIRCBIO-02-1)

Deadline: 1st stage: February 24th 2024; 2nd stage: September 17th 2024

Applicants: legal entities (public or private bodies) established in EU Member States or associated countries

Activity sectors: circular economy / textile

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o "cascade funding" è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette "open calls". Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell'ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

X2.0 Smart Cities & Sustainability Call

X2.0 4th Open Call aims at providing deep tech startups and SMEs with a 5-month growth program that aims to foster the launch, development, growth, and scaling of new products, services, processes, and integrated solutions in the Smart cities and Sustainability domain. Innovation Vouchers to cover: a) Needs-based growth and scaling services in the max. amount of €20.000; b) 1-on-1 mentorship with experts from the field of need in the min. amount of €5.000; c) Access large-scale startup and investor-oriented events, exhibitions, and fairs in the amount of €5.000.

Deadline: December 11th 2023

Applicants: Startups and SMEs established in EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries

Activity sectors: Smart cities and sustainability

Partnership: not required

InnoBuyer Call for Solvers

InnoBuyer offers a programme that brings together Challengers (public entities with unmet innovation needs) and Solvers (Innovative SMEs), to jointly co-create new solutions, applying a demand-driven approach. The InnoBuyer Call for Solvers aims to select and fund 15 innovative SMEs, to co-create pilots addressing the specific innovation needs (<u>Challenges</u>) of public organisations. Total budget: 1.200.000 €; up to 58.500 € lump-sum per selected solver.

Deadline: January 24th 2024

Applicants: Innovative SMEs from EU member states or Horizon Europe associated countries

Activity sectors: healthcare, transport, energy, artificial intelligence

Eurostars supports innovative SMEs and project partners (large companies, universities, research organisations and other types of organisations) by funding international collaborative R&D and innovation projects.
