[La Commissione presenta i risultati di un'iniziativa a sostegno delle regioni in transizione industriale](#)

La Commissione ha presentato i primi risultati di un'iniziativa avviata un anno fa per sostenere dieci regioni dell'UE - tra cui il Piemonte - e due Stati membri in transizione industriale, che avevano chiesto il sostegno e la competenza della Commissione per compiere la transizione industriale e definire strategie di sviluppo basate sui rispettivi settori di maggiore competitività, ossia di "[specializzazione intelligente](#)". Un primo risultato di questa iniziativa è costituito dal lancio di 12 progetti pilota, uno per regione o Stato membro in questione,

volti a superare ostacoli specifici alla transizione industriale. Ognuno dei progetti presentati oggi riceverà una sovvenzione dell'UE di 300 000 €.

[Previsioni economiche di primavera 2019: ancora crescita ma a ritmo più moderato](#)

Si prevede che nel 2019 l'economia europea continui a crescere per il settimo anno consecutivo, con un aumento del PIL reale in tutti gli Stati membri dell'UE. Dato il persistere di incertezze a livello globale, saranno le dinamiche interne a sostenere l'economia europea. La crescita dovrebbe accelerare nuovamente l'anno prossimo. Il recente rallentamento della crescita globale e del commercio mondiale, insieme all'elevata incertezza sulle politiche commerciali, incidono negativamente sulle prospettive di crescita del prodotto interno lordo (PIL) nel 2019 e nel 2020.

[Competition commissioner spells out terms for clearing new industrial R&D partnerships](#)

EU Competition Commissioner Margarethe Vestager spelled out some of the conditions that companies must meet in order to win Commission approval for an important new type of public-private R&D partnership. Vestager said that the new class of R&D projects – called Important Projects of Common European Interest (IPCEI) – are permissible if, among other things, they address a need the market cannot meet alone and do not unfairly harm competition.

[EU speeds up access to market of 13 innovative projects with €33 million](#)

The European Commission is awarding €33.12 million to bring innovative ideas to market quicker. The 13 benefitting projects, involving 54 partners in 17 countries, will receive around €2 million each with this first round of the [Fast Track to Innovation \(FTI\)](#) under the [European Innovation Council \(EIC\) pilot](#). The range of projects include a recycling technology for rubbers from old tyres, a magnetic ink barcode reader for anti-counterfeiting purposes, next generation photovoltaic windows, and a neuro-prosthesis that allows amputees to feel sensory feedback from the prosthesis.

[European Commission starts planning for €91.4B Horizon Europe implementation](#)

The European Commission has kicked-off the process of planning for implementation of the Horizon Europe research programme, convening the first meeting of the shadow programme committee which is responsible for overseeing preparation of the plan. Three revised public drafts will be released from June to October, when the Commission will invite opinions from industry, academia and others, about how to spend the money. That will provide inputs to the official draft that is to be agreed by member states, represented through the programme committee, in late 2019 or early 2020.

Preventing food waste, promoting Circular Economy: Commission adopts common methodology to measure food waste across the EU

Each year around 20% of food produced in the EU is lost or wasted, causing unacceptable social, environmental and economic harm. EU is committed to solving this problem and putting its food system onto a sustainable path. To be able to take effective action, we need more data on food waste than we currently have. In order to address this knowledge gap, the Commission has adopted a Delegated Act laying down a common food waste measurement methodology to support Member States in quantifying food waste at each stage of the food supply chain.

U.S. liquefied natural gas exports up by 272% as EU and U.S. host High-Level Business-to-Business Energy Forum

U.S. liquefied natural gas exports (LNG) up by 272% as EU and U.S. host High-Level Business-to-Business Energy Forum. In their [Joint Statement](#) of 25 July 2018 in Washington D.C., President Juncker and President Trump agreed to strengthen EU-U.S. strategic cooperation with respect to energy. Since then, U.S. LNG exports to the EU have been increasing substantially and have seen a steep rise, increasing by 272%. As a result, March 2019 recorded the highest volume ever of EU-U.S. trade in LNG with more than 1.4 billion cubic metres.

What are the EPA opportunities for EU dairy exporters to Japan? The EPA offers important market access opportunities for EU dairy exporters to Japan. Duties will be gradually phased out for hard cheeses and a tariff quota will allow for duty free access as from 1/4/2033 for fresh cheeses. Import market access improvement also for other dairy products such as butter, whey products and skimmed milk powder.
