CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 2021-2027. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e

anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Industry 5.0 Award 2023

The Industry 5.0 Award provides a vision of the future of European industry, which aims to achieve societal goals beyond jobs and growth. Projects competing for the Award should present inspiring and applicable solutions, addressing the 3 main pillars of Industry 5.0: sustainability, human-centricity and resilience. The concept of the award is prepared in collaboration with European Factories of the Future Research Association (EFFRA), industrial platform MANUFUTURE, European Innovation Council and SMEs Executive Agency (EISMEA) and EIT Manufacturing.

Deadline: September 1st 2023

Applicants: Eligible projects must have obtained funding from Horizon 2020, Horizon Europe or the European Institute of Innovation and Technology. The official start date of the project must be after 31 August 2018 and the projects' progress to date and results should have clear application in industry.

Activity sectors: industry 5.0: sustainability, human-centricity and resilience

Interregional Innovation Investments (I3) Instrument 2023 calls for proposals

The European Commission launched two new Interregional Innovation Investment (I3) Instrument calls, with a budget of 62 million €.

These calls are open to consortia of applicants from private organisations (SMEs, start-ups), public institutions and academia (universities, research organisations), focused on bringing innovations to a mature level, ready for commercialisation and scale-up, with a particular aim to develop new value chains in less developed regions and to integrate them into the broader EU value chains.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe and European Regional and Development Fund (ERDF)

Deadline: October 17th 2023

Applicants: legal entities (public or private bodies) established in EU member states or I3 associated countries

Thematic areas: Digital transition, Green transition, Smart manufacturing

Partnership: consortia must consist of a minimum of three to five independent legal entities from diverse regions

Horizon Europe: Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) Doctoral Networks 2023

MSCA Doctoral Networks will implement doctoral programmes, by partnerships of universities, research institutions and research infrastructures, businesses including SMEs, and other socio-economic actors from different countries across Europe and beyond. Through Industrial Doctorates, doctoral candidates will step outside academia and develop skills in industry and business by being jointly supervised by academic and non-academic organisations.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe, Pillar I – Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions

Call & Topic ID: MSCA Doctoral Networks 2023 (HORIZON-MSCA-2023-DN-01)

Deadline: November 28th 2023

Applicants: academic and non-academic organisations (including companies)

Activity sectors: multiple research/industrial fields

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o "cascade funding" è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette "open calls". Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell'ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

AEC Eurocluster open call

AEC Eurocluster (Architecture, Engineering and Construction Eurocluster for Future Built Environment) call for proposals for Project innovation, Technology Adoption, and Training is aimed at contributing to a more resilient, digital and low-carbon economic recovery of construction and related sectors of AEC Ecosystem, by supporting the implementation of market-demanded innovation projects. SMEs can receive lump sum financial support up to 60.000€.

Deadline: June 30th 2023

Applicants: SMEs from EU member states or Single Market Programme associated countries

Activity sectors: Architecture, Engineering and Construction; Circular economy; Green building; Advanced Building Materials; Bio based materials & 3D Printing; Construction Robotics; Workers` safety; Connected construction site; BIM & Construction monitoring; IT and related deep-tech having impact on built environment

Partnership: not required (only individual applications will be considered)

ADMA TranS4MErs - Second open call

ADMA TranS4MErs second Open Call aims to assist 800 European SMEs to implement innovative and advanced manufacturing solutions. The Transformation Program is organised in two phases, Design and Revamp. During the Design phase, SMEs receive up to 8 hours of dedicated support from a certified advisor to evaluate their business needs and digitalisation opportunities and design a tailored Transformation and Implementation Plan. During the Revamp phase, the SMEs receive up to €5.000 to be spent on selected innovation and consultancy services and tools, available in the ADMA TranS4MErs Catalogue, to complete their transformation journey and achieve their digitalisation goals.

Deadline: multiple cut-offs until January 17th 2024

Applicants: Manufacturing SMEs established in EU Member States

Activity sectors: advanced manufacturing / digital transformation

Partnership: not required

AIBC Euroclusters project (Artificial Intelligence & BlockChain for a greener and more digital economy) aims at supporting the development of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Blockchain (BC) solutions for different industrial ecosystems (manufacturing, mobility, logistics, energy) with the goal of supporting innovations related to the adoption of technologies that help SMEs meet the requirements for their green and digital transitions. AIBC Euroclusters will soon launch an open call (total budget 1,05 million €) to support European SMEs in their internationalization, digitization, resilience, energy transition and product/service development and innovation.

Planned opening dates: June 2023

Applicants: SMEs (AI/BC technology providers)

Activity sector: Artificial Intelligence/Blockchain solutions targeting manufacturing, mobility, logistics, energy
