CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

*Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 21-27. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.*

Horizon Europe: Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) Doctoral Networks 2023

MSCA Doctoral Networks will implement doctoral programmes, by partnerships of universities, research institutions and research infrastructures, businesses including SMEs, and other socio-economic actors from different countries across Europe and beyond. Through Industrial Doctorates, doctoral candidates

will step outside academia and develop skills in industry and business by being jointly supervised by academic and non-academic organisations.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe, Pillar I – Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions

Call & Topic ID: MSCA Doctoral Networks 2023 (HORIZON-MSCA-2023-DN-01)

Deadline: November 28th 2023

Applicants: academic and non-academic organisations (including companies)

Activity sectors: multiple research/industrial fields

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)



Partner search (Germany): Development of new bimetallic catalyst in frame of doctoral network under Horizon Europe

Horizon Europe: Demonstration of sustainable wave energy farms (Innovation Action)

Selected projects are expected to deploy a wave energy farm with a minimum capacity of 2 MW and operate the farm at least 2 years in the lifetime of the project. After the project it is expected that the farm will continue to be operated for at least 8 years. The project should develop and execute an effective operation and maintenance programme. Activities are expected to achieve TRL 8 by the end of the project. Call budget: 38.000.000 €; indicative number of grants: 2.

Call & Topic ID: Sustainable, secure and competitive energy supply (HORIZON-CL5-2024-D3-01-08)

Deadline: January 16th 2024

Applicants: legal entities (public or private bodies) established in EU Member States or associated countries

Activity sectors: sustainable energy production

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)



Partner search (Germany): Development of a new Wave Energy Converter (WEC) within the frame of a Horizon Europe project – coordinator and partners experienced in wave energy and hydrogen simulation required

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell’ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

E-BOOST Eurocluster Open calls

The E-BOOST Eurocluster launched five new calls in the mobility sector. The overall aim of the open calls is to identify product innovations to reduce dependency on critical inputs and technologies in the E-BOOST value chains, to introduce new-to-firm products or services, and to engage actors from regions with different levels of economic development. Applicants are entitled to apply and benefit from more than one type of E-BOOST Lump sums, with a combined maximum funding of € 60.000 per beneficiary.

- Mobility Lump Sum to SOLUTRANS mission, deadline to apply: 18 October 2023
- Innovation Support Services – electromobility sectors, deadline to apply: 31 October 2023
- Development of Innovative Communication Tools for E-BOOST Open Calls beneficiaries, deadline to apply: 31 October 2023
- Supporting innovative Products and Services development in electromobility sectors (bottom-up), deadline to apply: 8 November 2023
- Supporting innovative Products and Services development in electromobility sectors (Clean Hydrogen), deadline to apply: 8 November 2023

Applicants: SMEs based in a EU Member State or in a Single Market Programme associated country

Activity sectors: mobility

Partnership: not required (only applications by single applicants are allowed)

STAGE Financial Grant Programme – 1st Open call

Financial incentives are available to small and medium-sized enterprises to assist their sustainability transition. The Programme will grant up to 50.000 € per selected SME for two types of activities: a) Development of an investment project plan; b) Additional services, if needed for the investment plan preparation, such as: Feasibility study; Technology audit; Due diligence analysis; Data collection and analysis for carbon footprint assessment; Prototyping; Pilot testing; Pilot demonstrating; Adaptation of business processes; Support to use testing facilities; Procurement of other specialized consultancy and coaching services related to investment plan preparation.

Deadline: October 20th 2023

Applicants: SMEs based in a EU Member State or in a Horizon Europe associated country

Activity sectors: all 14 European Industrial Ecosystems defined by the EC, including: Textiles; Electronics; Mobility-Transport-Automotive; Energy-Intensive Industries; Renewable Energy; Agri-Food; Health; Digital; Construction; Retail; Proximity & Social Economy; Tourism; Creative & Cultural Industries and Aerospace & Defence

Partnership: not required

GEMSTONE Eurocluster GreenAdopt Open call

Gemstone project (GrEen Manufacturing Supporting recOvery and resilieNcE of industrial SMEs) GreenAdopt open call aims to facilitate the adoption of green smart solutions by industrial European SMEs. GreenAdopt financial support aims to fund the following type of activities: a) validation or/and demonstration of a solution, product, process, service or technology in a manufacturing environment in collaboration with another SME; b) implementation of a tested solution, product, process, service or technology in real environment in collaboration with another SME. The maximum financial support per project is €40.000 in the form of a lump sum.

Deadline: October 31st 2023

Applicants: manufacturing, technology and solution providers SMEs, and in particular industrial equipment and tool providers, based in a EU Member State or in a Single Market Programme associated country

Activity sector: Aeronautics/Defence; Energy; Mobility; Agriculture/Agri-food; Materials

Partnership: required (at least 2 SMEs from different NUTS-2 regions, 1 end-user SME and 1 technology or solution provider SME)

FORTHCOMING

Horizon Europe: Digital and emerging technologies for competitiveness and fit for the Green Deal (2024 calls for proposals)

Proposals for topics under this Destination should set out a credible pathway to contributing to the following expected impact: open strategic autonomy in digital technologies and in future emerging enabling technologies, by strengthening European capacities in key parts of digital and future supply chains, allowing agile responses to urgent needs, and by investing in early discovery and industrial uptake of new technologies.
