CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 2021-2027. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione

europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Horizon Europe: Low carbon-dioxide emission technologies for melting iron-bearing feed materials OR smart carbon usage and improved energy & resource efficiency via process integration (Clean Steel Partnership) (IA)

Related to the objectives for energy-intensive industries in general, the steel industry will be enabled to reduce its GHG emissions to the Fit for 55 targets, in particular contributing to fulfilling the new obligations foreseen in the revised ETS Directive to prepare for transition to climate neutrality and to take new pathways towards Circular Economy concepts.

Call & Topic ID: Twin green and digital transition 2023 (HORIZON-CL4-2023-TWIN-TRANSITION-01-43)

Deadline: April 20th 2023

Applicants: legal entities (public or private bodies) established in EU Member States or associated countries

Activity sector: green technologies applied to steel industry

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)



Partner search (Germany): HORIZON-CL4-2023-TWIN-TRANSITION-01-43 Industrial partners needing metal heating or scaling measurement are sought for a project with the objective to gradually substitute natural gas with hydrogen.

Horizon Europe: Clean Hydrogen JU call for proposals 2023

The Clean Hydrogen Partnership launched its hydrogen research call for proposals. A total of € 195 million will be made available for projects to support the creation of cutting-edge hydrogen technologies. The call includes 26 topics focusing on the following areas of research and innovation: Renewable Hydrogen Production; Hydrogen Storage and Distribution; Transport; Heat and Power; Cross-cutting; Hydrogen Valleys; Strategic Research challenge.

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell’ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

X2.0 1st Open Call

The first X2.0 Open Call and its 5-month growth program aims to foster the launch, development, growth, and scaling of new products, services, processes, and integrated solutions in the manufacturing and circular economy sectors, with a particular interest and focus on the circular approach to manufacturing. The project is looking for 10 deep-tech startups and SMEs to take part in the first growth program and deliver market-ready applications and technology solutions.

Deadline: March 16th 2023

Applicants: Startups and SMEs established in EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries

Activity sector: deeptech solutions for manufacturing & circular economy

Partnership: not required

AMULET 2nd Open Call

The H2020-INNOSUP-1 project AMULET published its second open call for cascade funding for SMEs, aiming at creating new value chains through projects that will foster the penetration of advanced lightweight materials

in specific sectors. AMULET will select up to 36 projects invited to a Jury Day, from which up to 26 will pass to the programme support services, and out of them, up to 7 will complete the full programme, following a funnel approach: a) up to 26 consortia (2-3 SMEs) to submit a feasibility study: 23.000 €; b) up to 7 consortia (2-3 SMEs) to demonstrate their solutions: 80.000 €; c) up to 7 consortia (2-3 SMEs) to get follow-up support services: 17.000 €

Deadline: March 22nd 2023

Applicants: SMEs established in EU Member States or H2020 associated countries

Activity sector: lightweight materials

Partnership: required (consortia of 2 to 3 SMEs)

On 25-28 April, CINEA will organise virtual EU information sessions to guide potential applicants. A dedicated virtual information session on the specificities of the calls for Clean energy transition will take place at the beginning of June 2023.
