CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli *obiettivi politici* della Commissione per la programmazione 2021-2027. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e

anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

European Partnership on Innovative SMEs / First Innowide call for market feasibility projects

The Innowide programme helps innovative SMEs with the ambition to compete in new international markets by supporting market feasibility projects. A market feasibility project includes preliminary technical, market, legal and/or socioeconomic assessments intended to validate the feasibility of international and innovative business solutions (product, process or service-market combination) within new and emerging global value chains. Each successful market feasibility project will receive a fixed grant of 60.000 euro.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe - European Partnership on the Innovative SMEs

Call & Topic ID: innowide-2022-call-01

Deadline: November 15th 2022

Applicants: Innovative SMEs, including young companies and start-ups from any sector

Activity sectors: multiple

Partnership: required (each market feasibility project must include at least an applicant SME and an independent subcontractor - local counterpart - in the target country).

Horizon Europe: MSCA Doctoral Networks 2022 – Industrial doctorates

MSCA Doctoral Networks will implement doctoral programmes, by partnerships of universities, research institutions and research infrastructures, businesses including SMEs, and other socio-economic actors from different countries across Europe and beyond. Through Industrial Doctorates, doctoral candidates will step outside academia and develop skills in industry and business by being jointly supervised by academic and non-academic organisations.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe, Pillar I – Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions

Call & Topic ID: MSCA Doctoral Networks 2022 (HORIZON-MSCA-2022-DN-01)

Deadline: November 15th 2022

Applicants: academic and non-academic organisations (including companies)

Activity sectors: multiple research/industrial fields

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)

Single Market Programme: Sustainable Growth and Building Resilience in Tourism - Empowering SMEs to carry out the twin transition

The action aims at guiding the forward-looking recovery of the tourism ecosystem by providing support, including with the intermediary of consortia of organisations of the relevant tourism industry stakeholders, to the digital and green transformation of tourism companies, particularly SMEs, and boosting innovation, resilience, sustainability and quality along the tourism value chain. The activity may also include provision of financial support to (e.g. SMEs and B2B matchmaking).

Funding programme: Single Market Programme

Call & Topic ID: Sustainable growth and building resilience in tourism – empowering support to SMEs to carry out the twin transition (SMP-COSME-2022-TOURSME)

Deadline: November 30th 2022

Applicants: business support organisations, destination management organisations

Activity sector: tourism

Partnership: required (Minimum 5/maximum 8 entities from minimum 5 different eligible countries)

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell’ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

2nd EIT Manufacturing Call 2023 for Innovation, Education and Business Creation proposals

EIT Manufacturing is looking for innovation, education and business creation projects addressing the EIT Manufacturing 2023 Call Thematics:

- Flexible Production Systems for Competitive Manufacturing;
- Low Environmental Footprint Systems & Circular Economy for Green Manufacturing;
- Digital & Collaborative Solutions for Innovative Manufacturing Ecosystems;
- Human-machine co-working for socially sustainable manufacturing.

Deadline: November 10th 2022

Applicants: organizations who are eligible for funding under the Horizon Europe programme; all EIT Manufacturing partners are eligible to apply for funding, nevertheless, an entity does not need to be an EIT partner to apply for funding

Activity sector: advanced manufacturing

Partnership: required (at least 2 partners established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)
