Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 2021-2027. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e

anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Horizon Europe: Europe's Rail Joint Undertaking 2022-2 Calls for proposals

EU-Rail JU is the European partnership for rail research and innovation under the Horizon Europe programme (2020-2027) and the successor to the Shift2Rail Joint Undertaking. This partnership aims to accelerate research and development in innovative technologies and operational solutions. Projects worth €35.8 million, against €14.7 million funding, are expected to be funded under the Europe's Rail 2022-2 Call for Proposals for Exploratory Research and Other Activities, within the framework of the Europe's Rail Amended Annual Work Programme 2022-2024.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe, Europe's Rail Joint Undertaking

Call & Topic ID: EU-RAIL JU Call Proposals 2022-02 (HORIZON-ER-JU-2022-02)

Deadline: December 14th 2022

Applicants: profit entities (Startups, SMEs, large companies); universities; public/private research centres; public administration; non-profit entities

Activity sector: transport/railway

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)

Connecting Europe Facility: 2022 CEF Transport Call

The 2022 CEF Transport call for proposals makes EUR 5.12 billion available for projects targeting new upgraded and improved European transport infrastructure. The indicative budget of the call is available to support infrastructure projects on the Core and Comprehensive TEN-T networks in the following areas: railways

inland waterways; maritime and inland ports; road safety; rail-road terminals; multimodal logistics platforms; multimodal passenger hubs; smart and interoperable applications for transport; safe and secure mobility; infrastructure resilience.

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o "cascade funding" è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette "open calls". Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell'ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

BonsAPPs 2nd Open Call for AI Adopters SMEs

BonsAPPs is an EU-funded H2020 project that will help SMEs in their digitalization process by allowing them to access, implement and make use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in an easy and affordable way through Boneyes AI Marketplace (BMP). Selected SMEs will receive up to 74.000 euro covering costs needed to participate in 6-month programme and a voucher to engage external AI experts and HPC providers.

Deadline: November 2nd 2022

Applicants: SMEs with an interest to implement AI solutions

ADMA TranS4MErs First Open Call
