## CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 2021-2027. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e

anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

#### **Single Market Programme: Buy social: business to business market**

The action will support the creation of local and regional partnerships aiming at reinforcing policy initiatives to improve collaboration between social economy entities and mainstream businesses in their supply chain strategies. In particular, these partnerships will aim at helping mainstream businesses to engage with a range of social economy suppliers and embeds sustainability and diversity into their core operations and value chains. It will also help social enterprises to grow their revenues and impact by tapping into corporate purchasing power.

**Funding programme:** Single Market Programme

**Call & Topic ID:** Boosting awareness raising for mainstream enterprises to work with social enterprises (towards a 'buy social' business to business market - SMP-COSME-2022-BUYSOCIALB2BMARKET)

**Deadline:** December 7<sup>th</sup> 2022

**Applicants:** legal entities established in EU Member States or SMP associated countries

**Activity sector:** social economy

**Partnership:** required (Minimum 5/maximum 10 entities from minimum 3 different eligible countries; consortia must include minimum 1 social economy organisation per eligible country and at least 1 social economy network, association, sector federation or support organisation working on EU level)

#### **Digital Europe Programme: Specialised education programmes or modules in key capacity areas**

The action aims at increasing and improving the offer of education programmes and the number of students specialised in key capacity areas. The action will support cooperation between higher education institutions and the private sector, together with research and excellence centres in digital technologies, including those funded in the other actions of the programme. The goal is to encourage organisations to work together and develop ecosystems of excellence able to train, attract and retain the best digital talents.

**Funding programme:** Digital Europe Programme

**Call & Topic ID:** Advanced Digital Skills (DIGITAL-2022-SKILLS-03)

**Deadline:** January 24<sup>th</sup> 2023

**Applicants:** legal entities (public or private bodies) established in different EU Member States

**Activity sector:** digital skills

**Partnership:** required (minimum 3 partners from 3 different eligible countries)

## **CASCADE FUNDING**

*Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o "cascade funding" è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette "open calls". Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell'ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).*

#### **HosmartAI Open Call#2 – EXPERIMENT**

HosmartAI aims to increase the outreach and adoption of the HosmartAI platform, by supporting the deployment of new pilots across the EU, within various types of healthcare entities. Through Open Call #2 – EXPERIMENT, HosmartAI is calling for pilots made of small consortia of 2–3 partners. 4 innovative pilots by European SMEs/start-ups are expected to be implemented, demonstrating the value and benefits of HosmartAI technologies in different healthcare environments across Europe. Selected projects will receive grants up to 145.000 €.

**Deadline:** November 15<sup>th</sup> 2022

**Applicants:** Technology providers: SMEs/Startups; Technology adopters: healthcare facilities

**Activity sector:** AI for healthcare

**Partnership:** required (2/3 partners)

#### **DIGITOUR: Call for Proposals for Tourism SMEs**

The DIGITOUR project will support at least 138 tourism SMEs, by improving their digital maturity, skills and capacities. In particular, DIGITOUR aims at: enhancing tourism SMEs' knowledge of digital tools (Voucher 1: 1.000 €), and boosting innovative ideas for digital solutions by SMEs to improve their offer and foster cross-sectoral and cross-border partnerships among tourism SMEs, relevant stakeholders and technology providers (Voucher 2: 20.000€ per consortium).

**Deadline:** Voucher 2: November 30<sup>th</sup> 2022; Voucher 1: March 31<sup>st</sup> 2023

**Applicants:** Tourism SMEs (NACE codes: I5510, I5520, I5530, N79)

**Activity sector:** tourism

**Partnership:** Voucher 2: required / Voucher 1: not required

### **I-ENERGY Second Open Call for Developing new services on top of existing technologies**

I-ENERGY project aims at reshaping the energy sector value chain towards better business and operational performance, increased environmental sustainability and the creation of a stronger social fabric propagating high social value among citizens. In this Open Call, I-ENERGY will select 15 bottom-up projects for the Technology Transfer Programme 2, which is aimed at developing new services on top of existing technologies (Minimum Viable Products). Consortia must be composed of 2 partners: 1 service developer/provider with SME status and 1 infrastructure provider/data owner willing to implement an energetic solution. Winning projects will receive up to 100.000 € and a 9-month mentoring program.

**Deadline:** December 12<sup>th</sup> 2022

**Applicants:** SMEs/Startups

**Activity sector:** Artificial Intelligence

**Partnership:** required
