CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 21-27. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e

anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Clean Energy Transition – CETPartnership Joint Call 2022

The CETPartnership Joint Call 2022 is the first annual call under the CETPartnership and is co-funded by the European Commission under the Horizon Europe Partnership scheme. The CETPartnership aims at funding projects that develop applicative solutions and provide results for the clean energy transition. Most projects are expected to aim for solutions meeting medium to high technology readiness levels (TRL 6-8), combining technologies, market related solutions and stakeholder involvement. All project proposals must be submitted through the [CETPartnership Application Portal](#).

Funding programme: Horizon Europe through National funding bodies (MUR - MISE)

Call & Topic ID: CETPartnership Joint Call 2022

Deadline: Pre-proposal: November 23rd 2022 / Full proposal: March 23rd 2023

Applicants: legal entities (public or private bodies) established in CETPartnership participating countries

Activity sector: clean energy transition technologies

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities from at least 3 different countries participating in the CETPartnership Joint Call 2022, out of which at least 2 must be EU Member States or Horizon Europe Associated Countries.

Innovation Fund third call for large-scale projects

The European Commission launched on 3 November 2022 the EU Innovation Fund third call for large-scale projects in the field of demonstration of innovative low-carbon technologies, with a total budget of EUR 3 billion and four topics:

- Innovative electrification in industry and hydrogen
- Clean-tech manufacturing
- Mid-sized pilots
- General decarbonisation

Funding programme: Innovation Fund

Call & Topic ID: Innovation Fund Large Scale Projects (InnovFund-2022-LSC)

Deadline: March 16th 2023

Applicants: legal entities (public or private bodies) established in any country in the world

Activity sectors: low-carbon technologies (proposals must relate to activities taking place in EU Member States, Norway or Iceland)

Partnership: not required

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell’ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

DigiPrime Open Call (Type B)

DigiPrime Open Call Type B will finance: a) proposals expanding the DigiPrime already existing Pilots to connect with sectors/pilots that provide or use materials, as well as components in/from the DigiPrime pilots; b) proposals investigating new pilots focusing on the same components and materials of the DigiPrime already existing pilots, but exploring novel and different application contexts; c) proposals focusing on totally new pilots. The total Funds available are EUR 1.2 million. The funding rate is 70%, the maximum DigiPrime contribution per single applicant is €100.000 (up to €200.000 for consortia).

Deadline: January 10th 2023

Applicants: SMEs / consortia of SMEs

Activity sector: digital technologies

Partnership: optional

SMART4ALL Third FTTE Open Call

SMART4ALL project provides up to €80.000 funding to Focused Technology Transfer Experiments (FTTEs), on one of the following areas: digitized environment, digitized agriculture, digitized anything and digitized transport. Funding provided will give the opportunity to form synergies, accelerate product oriented projects and offer guidance towards successful commercialisation.

Deadline: January 17th 2023

Applicants: Universities or Academic Institutions; SME and slightly bigger companies

Activity sector: digital technologies

Partnership: required (consortia composed of two different entities from two different countries including one Academic/Industrial partner who acts as a Technology Provider and an Industrial partner acting as a Technology Receiver)

WORTH II 2nd call

Funded via the COSME Programme, WORTH is all about creating and supporting transnational partnerships between designers, crafters, SME manufacturers, tech-firms and start-ups across EU-27, UK or COSME countries looking to develop design-driven and innovative products. The project focuses on lifestyle industries, including fashion and textile, footwear, leather and furniture/home decoration/interior design, jewellery and accessories. Selected project will benefit from an incubator programme including €10.000 to €20.000 seed money.

Deadline: February 15th 2023

Applicants: designers, crafters, SME manufacturers, tech-firms and start-ups

Activity sector: lifestyle industries

Partnership: required
