CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 2021-2027. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione

europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Social Prerogative and Specific Competencies Lines: Improving expertise in the field of industrial relations

The objective of this call is to promote analysis and research on industrial relations, at EU level as well as in comparative terms (identifying convergences and differences in the industrial relations systems in place in the EU Member States and in Candidate Countries), thereby contributing and promoting exchange of information and experience among the parties actively involved in industrial relations, with the aim of contributing to developing and reinforcing industrial relations structures in Europe.

Funding programme: Social Prerogative and Specific Competencies Lines (SOCPL)

Call & Topic ID: Improving expertise in the field of industrial relations (SOCPL-2022-IND-REL)

Deadline: February 7th 2023

Applicants: social partners organisations established in eligible countries (EU Member States or candidate countries)

Activity sector: industrial relations

Partnership: not required

Single Market Programme: Greening social economy SMEs and entrepreneurs in the proximity and social economy ecosystem through transnational co-operation

The main objective of this call for proposals is to green the processes and activities of SMEs in the social economy by boosting the development of sustainable practices through capacity building, knowledge transfer and transnational cooperation. At least 50% of the grant must be directed to SMEs to finance services in support of their greater resilience and green and digital transformation, e.g. lump sums for support services, or free access and support to use testing facilities directly to SMEs. The available call budget is EUR 3 million. It is expected to fund between 6 and 8 proposals.

Funding programme: Single Market Programme

Call & Topic ID: Greening social economy SMEs and entrepreneurs in the proximity and social economy ecosystem through transnational co-operation (SMP-COSME-2022-SEE)

Deadline: February 14th 2023

Applicants: legal entities (public or private bodies) established in EU or SMP associated countries

Activity sector: social economy

Partnership: required (at least 6 independent entities from at least 3 different eligible countries; at least 1 social economy intermediary per participating country involved in the consortium; a minimum of 1 and a maximum of 2 support organisations active at EU level)

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell’ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

South3E 1st open call

The consortium of S3E – Southern European Entrepreneurship Engine has launched its first open call as part of the development of an engine of growth that will improve the connections and efficiency of the entrepreneurship ecosystems in Southern European countries. The call is built around 3 tracks of services tailored to start-ups’ varying levels of maturity (i.e., early, growth, and scaling stages). The S3E Reverse track also foresees the involvement of larger companies, corporations, and public organisations to submit a challenge through Open Call Mechanism.

Deadline: February 10th 2023

Applicants: Startups / SMEs (solvers) and larger companies (challengers)

Activity sector: deep tech targeting at least one of the Sustainable Development Goals.

Partnership: not required

EU DigiTOUR Call for selection of innovative Tourism SMEs

The EU DigiTOUR is a project co-funded by the COSME Programme of the European Union, with the scope to support the digital transformation of the European tourism SMEs lagging behind in the adoption and full exploitation of the digital technologies in the tourism industry. The project scheme was designed to help shape the next generation EU tourism SMEs to untap the potentials of the digital realm, enhancing cooperation in the tourism ecosystem for the development of new, innovative, and smart tourism solutions, products, services, skills, and new business models by the use of AI, IoT, VR and AR, and big data.

Deadline: February 16th 2023

Applicants: Innovative Tourism SMEs (NACE codes: I55, N79) established in Italy, Germany, Croatia, Slovenia

Activity sector: tourism

Partnership: not required

REACH 3rd Open Call for Data driven Startups

The call will fund the execution of projects led by SMEs including a Data Value Chain (DVC) scenario where value is created from the sharing of data, proposing innovative products and services making use of Big Data tools but also adhering to one of the participation tracks defined below. The program is looking for around 35 promising big data startups and SMEs to take part in its third round of incubation.

Deadline: February 21st 2023

Applicants: Startups / SMEs

Activity sector: data value chain

Partnership: not required

FORTHCOMING

Innovative Health Initiative (IHI) call 3 and 4

The Innovative Health Initiative (IHI) will launch call 3 and call 4 in December 2022 and January 2023, respectively. The following draft topics are under consideration for inclusion in the next calls for proposals:

IHI call 3 (single stage call)

- Topic 1: Screening platform and biomarkers for prediction and prevention of diseases of unmet public health need
- Topic 2: Patient generated evidence to improve outcomes, support decision making, and accelerate innovation
- Topic 3: Combining hospital interventional approaches to improve patient outcomes and increase hospital efficiencies
- Topic 4: Strengthening the European ecosystem for Advanced Therapy Medicinal Products (ATMPs) and other innovative therapeutic modalities for rare diseases
- Topic 5: Digital health technologies for the prevention and personalised management of mental disorders and their long-term health consequences

IHI call 4 (two stage call)

- Topic 1: Expanding translational knowledge in minipigs: a path to reduce and replace non-human primates in non-clinical drug safety assessment
- Topic 2: Patient-centric blood sample collection to enable decentralised clinical trials and improve access to healthcare
