CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 2021-2027. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **calls for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e

anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Innovation Fund: Small Scale Projects

The objectives of this call are to: (a) support projects demonstrating highly innovative technologies, processes, business models or products/services, that are sufficiently mature and have a significant potential to reduce greenhouse gas emissions; (b) offer financial support tailored to market needs and risk profiles of eligible projects, while attracting additional public and private resources.

Funding programme: Innovation Fund

Call & Topic ID: Innovation Fund Small Scale Projects (InnovFund-2021-SSC)

Deadline: August 31st 2022

Applicants: legal entities established in eligible countries (proposals must relate to activities taking place in EU Member States, Norway or Iceland. Projects may also be located in Northern Ireland on the condition that the

project concerns the generation, transmission, distribution or supply of electricity).

Thematic areas: low-carbon technologies and processes

Partnership: not required

Horizon Europe: Integration of social innovation actors in innovation ecosystems (Coordination and Support Action)

The action aims to raise awareness and ease the access of social entrepreneurs to the resources of pan-European, national, regional and local innovation ecosystems. In addition, the action aims to have a lasting spill-over effect by bringing attention to the benefits of social innovation projects to the society as a whole, and to strategic priorities and objectives of the Commission in particular.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe – European Innovation Ecosystems

Call & Topic ID: Interconnected Innovation Ecosystems (2022.1) (HORIZON-EIE-2022-CONNECT-01)

Deadline: April 26th 2022

Applicants: Social innovation actors/social entrepreneurs, SMEs, start-ups, accelerators and business incubators, investors, industry, foundations and philanthropy societies, universities and RTOs public-owned enterprises.

Thematic areas: social innovation

Partnership: Applications may be submitted by one or more legal entities established in eligible countries

Social Prerogative and Specific Competencies Lines: Support for social dialogue

This call aims at contributing to the promotion of social dialogue at cross-industry and sectoral level, developing European social dialogue, and building and strengthening the capacity of national social partners, in particular following the Covid crisis. European social dialogue refers to discussions, consultations, negotiations and joint actions involving organisations representing either side of industry (employers or workers).

Funding programme: Social Prerogative and Specific Competencies Lines Programme

Call & Topic ID: Support for social dialogue (SOCPL-2022-SOC-DIALOG)

Deadline: June 30th 2022

Applicants: social partners organisations established in eligible countries (EU Member States or candidate countries)

Activity sector: social dialogue

Partnership: not required

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali calls for proposals.

EIT Digital Innovation Factory 2022 (second cut-off)

'Innovation Factory 2022' targets entrepreneurial minds planning to launch or boost a deep tech venture. The work programme is guided by the [EIT Digital Strategic Innovation Agenda 2022-2024](#), which identifies the five focus areas of our strategy: Digital Tech, Digital Industry, Digital Cities, Digital Wellbeing and Digital Finance. Organisations in the selected proposals are expected to be or become Partner of EIT Digital. Applicants can submit their activity proposals at any moment in time throughout 2022, with 3 pre-defined cut off dates for evaluation.

Next deadline: June 1st 2022

Applicants: pan-European entrepreneurial teams from education, research, and business organisations

Activity sector: digital technologies

Partnership: required

SmartAgriHubs – SERVICE the SmartAgriHubs Community Network

Open call for projects coordinated by Digital Innovation Hubs (DIHs) that aim at services for the support of digital transformation in the agri-food domain. For this call, projects shall develop, innovate, provide, validate and/or improve services provided by Digital Innovation Hubs. Tangible innovation services shall be provided by DIHs. They shall aim at supporting the set-up and realisation of digital innovation activities realised by stakeholders of agri-food communities and related networks.

Deadline: June 29th 2022

Applicants: one or more Digital Innovation Hubs

Activity sector: agri-food

Partnership: not required

Horizon Europe: EIC Pathfinder Challenge - Mid to long term and systems integrated energy storage

This EIC Pathfinder Challenge aims at providing solutions that will optimise European energy storage and thus enable demand response strategies and capabilities to host higher penetration of intermittent renewable technologies. Proposed solutions with multidisciplinary and cross-sectorial approaches, looking for inspiration, ideas and knowledge in a broad range of disciplines are particularly welcome.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe – European Innovation Council

Call & Topic ID: EIC Pathfinder Challenges 2022 (HORIZON-EIC-2022-PATHFINDERCHALLENGES-01)

Planned opening date: June 16th 2022

Deadline: October 19th 2022

Applicants: startups, SMEs, universities; public/private research centres

Activity sector: energy

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries).
