Horizon Europe: EIC Accelerator Challenge - Technologies for ‘Fit for 55’

This EIC Accelerator Challenge aims at supporting the development and scaling up of technologies and boosting breakthrough innovations that strengthen the green transition, having a high potential to meet the following goals: Higher clean energy conversion and use; Decarbonisation of hard-to-abate industries; Energy efficiency and safety in the built environment; Zero emission mobility solutions; Climate neutrality in the land use; Water, gas and indoor air management/monitoring systems; Green digital technologies.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe – European Innovation Council

Call & Topic ID: EIC Accelerator 2022 (HORIZON-EIC-2022-ACCELERATOR-01)

Next cut-offs: June 15th, October 5th 2022

Applicants: Startups, Innovative SMEs, Small Mid-Caps

Creative Europe: Innovation lab

The Creative Innovation Lab shall incentivise players from different cultural and creative sectors to design and test innovative digital solutions with a potential positive long-term impact on multiple cultural and creative sectors. The Lab shall facilitate the creation of innovative solutions (e.g. tools, models and methodologies) that can apply to the audiovisual sector and at least another creative and/or cultural sector. Thematic focus is on “greening” as well as “innovative education tools to tackle relevant societal topics”.

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals.

MIND4MACHINES 1st Open Call

MIND4MACHINES project aims at facilitating the cross-sectoral and cross-border support needed by manufacturing SMEs to test and adopt the latest digital technologies for transformation towards smarter, greener, and more resource-efficient manufacturing, aligned with the latest EU policies. The first open call (1,5M€) is now open with the aim of funding and encouraging the validation of new cross-sectoral and cross-regional digital manufacturing value chains, delivering innovative goods, services and processes in new sectors.

Deadline: June 29th 2022

Applicants: SMEs and startups (ICT providers and manufacturing companies)

Activity sector: digital manufacturing

Partnership: not required

PhotonHUB Europe

PhotonHUB Europe project was funded under Horizon 2020 with the aim of accelerating the uptake of photonics technologies by European industry, through the establishment of a full-service one-stop-shop Photonics Innovation Hub offering a broad range of services covering: training and upskilling opportunities within PhotonHub’s Demo and Experience Centres, ‘test before invest’ to engage with companies with highly collaborative innovation projects, and investment readiness coaching and investor matchmaking.

Deadline: always open

Applicants: SMEs / Midcaps

Activity sector: photonics technologies and related industrial applications

Partnership: not required

EU ECO-TANDEM PROGRAMME Call for Participation

The present call is being launched in the framework of the EU ECO-TANDEM Project, co-funded by the COSME Programme of the European Union. The objective of the call is to encourage partnerships (so called "Tandems") between traditional tourism SMEs and tourism innovative startups and innovators, for a mutual benefit cooperation, providing them with technical and financial support to facilitate the European Tourism SMEs eco-transition.

Deadline: May 15th 2022

Applicants: traditional tourism SMEs / tourism startups or innovative SMEs

Activity sector: tourism

Metabuilding 2nd Grow/Harvest call

The GROW/HARVEST call aims at stimulating the cross-sectoral collaboration of SMEs in the framework of innovative projects with a financing of maximum 60.000 EUR. The collaborative projects should serve as a basis to help SMEs to learn from what is going on in other sectors and use knowledge, expertise and technology assets from other sectors to increase their performance and productivity.

Deadline: May 25th 2022

Applicants: SMEs

Activity sector: building / construction

Partnership: required

FORTHCOMING

Horizon Europe: Demonstration of complete value chains for advanced biofuel and non-biological renewable fuel production (Innovation Action)

Proposals should demonstrate innovative and cost effective sustainable value chains for advanced biofuels or synthetic renewable fuels of non-biological origin (other than for hydrogen as a final product), over the entire cycle from feedstock to end use. Any sustainable biomass feedstock including residues and wastes, or biogenic CO₂ or industrial CO₂ and renewable hydrogen, as well as input energy to the conversion should be addressed. **Funding programme:** Horizon Europe – Cluster 5 Climate, Energy and Mobility

Call & Topic ID: Sustainable, secure and competitive energy supply (HORIZON-CL5-2022-D3-02-08)

Planned opening date: May 26th 2022

Deadline: October 27th 2022

Applicants: profit entities (Startups, SMEs, large companies); universities; public/private research centres; public administration; non-profit entities

Activity sector: sustainable energy supply

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries).
