CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 2021-2027. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **calls for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e

anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Horizon Europe: Innovative solutions to prevent adulteration of food bearing quality labels: focus on organic food and geographical indications (Innovation Action)

Proposals should investigate the current fraud practices affecting quality labelled food products, in particular organic and GI, and analyse the root causes/drivers of these practices and obstacles and ways to eradicate them. Proposals should develop/improve, test, demonstrate and pilot promising innovative low-cost methods, tools and approaches to authenticate and/or trace quality labelled food products, especially organic and GIs, as well as to improve transparency of their supply chains from farm to fork.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe, Cluster 6 - Food, Bioeconomy, Natural Resources, Agriculture and Environment

Call & Topic ID: Fair, healthy and environmentally-friendly food systems from primary production to consumption (HORIZON-CL6-2022-FARM2FORK-01-04)

Deadline: February 15th 2022

Applicants: profit entities (Startups, SMEs, large companies); universities; public/private research centres; public administration; non-profit entities

Activity sector: agrifood

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)

Horizon Europe: Optimised Industrial Systems and Lines through digitalisation (Innovation Action)

Digital tools can enable industry to control manufacturing processes and address issues more efficiently and effectively as they run and update the production plant, while improving key product and production performance indicators such as yield and throughput. Proposals under this topic have to design robust digital tools integrating materials modelling and materials process development for industry.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe, Cluster 4 – Digital, Industry and Space

Call & Topic ID: A digitised, resource-efficient and resilient industry 2022 (HORIZON-CL4-2022-RESILIENCE-01-25)

Deadline: March 30th 2022

Applicants: profit entities (Startups, SMEs, large companies); universities; public/private research centres; public administration; non-profit entities

Activity sector: digital technologies for manufacturing industry

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)

Horizon Europe: Innovative materials for advanced (nano)electronic components and systems (Research and Innovation Action)

Actions under this topic must address one or more of the following technologies: a) Innovative materials design and processing for devices based on new and emerging technologies, including advanced methods of data driven materials design (e.g. spintronics, neuromorphic, in-material computing multisensing, photonics, nano-mechanics advanced ferroelectrics or biosensing); b) Heterogeneous integration of new materials (such as PZT, graphene, titanium oxide or aluminium oxide, etc.) for miniaturised sensor and actuator modules.

Call & Topic ID: A digitised, resource-efficient and resilient industry 2022 (HORIZON-CL4-2022-RESILIENCE-01-10)

Deadline: March 30th 2022

Applicants: profit entities (Startups, SMEs, large companies); universities; public/private research centres; public administration; non-profit entities.

Activity sector: new materials for industrial applications

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or associated countries)

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali calls for proposals.

AI4Media – Open Call #1

The main objective of the AI4Media – Open Call #1 is to engage entrepreneurs, companies (e.g., SMEs, mid-caps) and researchers that regularly develop and integrate applied research in the field of AI, to develop new research and applications for AI, and contribute to the enrichment of the pool of technological tools of the AI4Media (AI4EU) platform. It is expected that 10 applicants be selected in each of the tracks of the open call, with a maximum budget of €50 000 per applicant.

Deadline: December 1st 2021

Applicants: SMEs / mid-caps / researchers

Activity sector: artificial intelligence / media

Partnership: not required

EIT Food Open Call 2022

EIT Food is calling for consortia of organisations to submit proposals for collaborative activities which will bring innovative technology solutions to the market in the agrifood sector within the scope of EIT Food's Impact Framework, as described in the [Strategic Agenda 2021-27](#).

Deadline: January 14th 2022

Applicants: all organisations eligible for Horizon Europe: SMEs, large companies, research organisations, public authorities, NGOs (successful organisations will be required to complete the onboarding process to become a Food KIC Partner and accede to the Grant Agreement (GA) signed with the EIT).

Activity sector: agrifood

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or associated countries)

Digital Europe Programme: call for European Digital Innovation Hubs

European Digital Innovation Hubs (EDIHs) will function as one-stop shops that help companies dynamically respond to the digital challenges and become more competitive. European Digital Innovation Hubs will have both local and European functions. EU funding will be made available for hubs that are already (or will be) supported by their Member States (or regions), in order to increase the impact of public funding. The Digital Europe Programme will increase the capacities of the selected hubs to cover activities with a clear European added value, based on networking the hubs and promoting the transfer of expertise.
