Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

New! First LIFE Call for Proposals 2021 opened with over EUR 580 million available

On 13 July the first LIFE Call for Proposals opened under the new LIFE programme 2021-2027, which comprises four sub-programmes:

- Nature and biodiversity
- Circular economy and quality of life
- Climate change mitigation and adaptation
- Clean energy transition

Creative Europe Programme (CULTURE strand): European Cooperation projects

This action will support projects involving a large diversity of players active in different cultural and creative sectors, to carry out a broad spectrum of activities and initiatives. Support will be given to cooperation projects contributing to the following objectives: a) Transnational creation and circulation: to strengthen the transnational creation and circulation of European works and artists; b) Innovation: to enhance the capacity of European cultural and creative sectors to nurture talents, to innovate, to prosper and to generate jobs and growth.

Funding programme: Creative Europe Programme (CREA) – CULTURE strand

Call & Topic ID: European Cooperation projects (CREA-CULT-2021-COOP)

Deadline: September 7th 2021

Applicants: Cultural and creative organisations, cinemas, films

Activity sector: music, publishing, cultural heritage and architecture

Partnership: required

Horizon Europe: Development of more energy efficient electrically heated catalytic reactors (Innovation Action)

A shift from fired- to electrically-heated catalytic reactors, powered by renewables will lead to a large decrease in CO₂ emissions, contributing to the greening of large industries. This requires the re-design of the reactor, in parallel with the development of novel catalysts and the integration of up and downstream processes to operate with optimal energy efficiency and product yield.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe, Cluster 4 – Civil security for society

Call & Topic ID: A digitised, resource-efficient and resilient industry 2021 (HORIZON-CL4-2021-RESILIENCE-01-14)

Deadline: September 23rd, 2021

Applicants: profit entities (Startups, SMEs, large companies); universities; public/private research centres; public administration; non-profit entities.

Activity sector: energy efficiency

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)

Horizon Europe: EIC Pathfinder Challenges 2021

EIC Pathfinder Challenges aim to build on new, cutting-edge directions in science and technology to disrupt an existing market or create new opportunities by realising innovative technological solutions grounded in high-risk/high-gain research and development. Specific challenges now open for calls for proposals:

- Awareness inside (artificial intelligence)
- Tools to measure and stimulate activity in brain tissue
- Emerging technologies in cell and gene therapy (CGT)
- Novel routes to green hydrogen production
- Engineered living materials

Funding programme: Horizon Europe – European Innovation Council

Deadline: October 27th, 2021

Applicants: startups, SMEs, universities; public/private research centres

Activity sector: depending on the specific challenge

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries).

Horizon Europe: Fast deployed mobile laboratories to enhance situational awareness for pandemics and emerging infectious diseases (Innovation Action)

The recent COVID-19 crisis has demonstrated that the ability to rapidly identify viruses on scene under a proper quality control/assurance regime is crucial to ensure adequate risk assessment, optimal risk management, and proper counter measures. In the EU Civil Protection and Health policy framework, mobile laboratories are increasingly becoming part of crisis responses and recovery plans, and the COVID-19 illustrated the needs for further developments in this area.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe, Cluster 3 – Civil security for society

Call & Topic ID: Disaster-Resilient Society 2021 (HORIZON-CL3-2021-DRS-01-05)

Deadline: November 23rd, 2021

Applicants: profit entities (Startups, SMEs, large companies); universities; public/private research centres; public administration; non-profit entities.

Activity sector: security related to health

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali calls for proposals.

TRUBLO 2nd Open Call

The TRUBLO open call wishes to support the implementation of small scale research projects on one of the two topics: a) Trust and reputation models on blockchains; b) Topic Proof-of-validity and proof-of-location. TRUBLO aims to provide access to a 15-month support programme divided in two phases:

1. **Innovation phase** (duration: 9 months; funding: 75.000€): up to 15 projects will be selected to develop their proposed project and prepare a publication (whitepaper or scientific article) describing their solution.
2. **Progress phase** (duration: 6 months; funding: 100.000€): A subset of 3 projects from Phase 1 will be selected to further develop activities associated with the demonstration/piloting as well as promotion and exploitation of their project, building an MVP as demonstrator and aiming to engage new customers and/or partners and/or investors.

Deadline: September 10th 2021

Applicants: SMEs, startups, academic teams, researchers.

Activity sector: blockchain technology

Partnership: required

TouriSME programme - Call for SMEs

Selected SMEs will have access to: trainings for knowledge transfer, matchmaking events for international cooperation and knowledge exchanges and tailored mentoring and financial support to access environmental certifications. These capacity building activities will enable companies to put in place sustainable practices in their business by consuming less energy and resources, producing less waste and offering new ways of traveling in line with the markets, among others. Projects could be funded up to 7,000€.

Deadline: September 15th 2021

Applicants: SMEs from one the following tourism sectors: Hotels and similar accommodation; holiday and other short-stay accommodation; travel agencies, tour operator reservation service and related activities.

Activity sector: tourism

Partnership: not required

Horizon Europe: ICT Innovation for Manufacturing Sustainability in SMEs (I4MS2 - Made in Europe Partnership) (Innovation Action)

ICT Innovation for Manufacturing SMEs (I4MS2) calls for Innovation Action projects that will support European SMEs and mid-caps to innovate and make more sustainable their products, production processes and business models through experimentation and testing. At least 50% of the budget should be allocated to SMEs and mid-caps to participate in the experiments. The proposals may include financial support to third parties to finance SMEs and mid-caps.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe, Cluster 4 – Digital, Industry and Space

Call & Topic ID: Climate neutral, circular and digitised production 2022 (HORIZON-CL4-2022-TWIN-TRANSITION-01-06)

Planned opening date: October 12th, 2021

Deadline: March 30th, 2021

Applicants: profit entities (Startups, SMEs, large companies); universities; public/private research centres; public administration; non-profit entities.

Activity sector: ICT
