CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 2021-2027. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **calls for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Creative Europe Programme (CULTURE strand): Creative Innovation Lab

The Creative Innovation Lab shall incentivise players from different cultural and creative sectors to design and test innovative digital solutions with a potential positive long-term impact on multiple cultural and creative sectors. The Lab shall facilitate the creation of innovative solutions (e.g. tools, models and methodologies) that can apply to the audiovisual sector and at least another creative and/or cultural sector. Solutions should be easily replicable and have a potential for market penetration.

Funding programme: Creative Europe Programme (CREA) – CULTURE strand

Call & Topic ID: Innovation Lab (CREA-CROSS-2021-INNOVLAB)

Deadline: October 5th 2021

Applicants: Cultural and creative organisations, cinemas, films

Activity sector: music, publishing, cultural heritage and architecture

Partnership: required

Horizon Europe: EIC Accelerator Open 2021

The EIC Accelerator address companies (principally start-ups and SMEs) to scale up high impact innovations with the potential to create new markets or disrupt existing ones, supporting the later stages of technology development as well as scale-up. The technology component of the innovation must therefore have been tested and validated in a laboratory or other relevant environment (e.g. at least Technology Readiness Level 5/6 or higher).

Funding programme: Horizon Europe - EIC Accelerator Open 2021

Next deadline: October 6th 2021

Applicants: Startups, Innovative SMEs, Small Mid-Caps

Activity sector: any field of technology or application

Partnership: not required

Horizon Europe: EIC Accelerator Challenges 2021

You should apply to the EIC Accelerator Challenges if your innovation addresses the following topics:

- a) Green Deal innovations for the Economic Recovery
- b) Strategic Digital and Health Technologies

Funding programme: Horizon Europe - EIC Accelerator Challenges 2021

Next deadline: October 6th 2021

Applicants: Startups, Innovative SMEs, Small Mid-Caps

Activity sector: a) Sustainability; b) Digital / Healthcare

Partnership: not required

Horizon Europe: Women TechEU (European Innovation Ecosystems)

The scheme offers coaching and mentoring to female founders, as well as targeted funding (75.000€ grant) to support the initial steps in the innovation process, and the growth of the company.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe – European Innovation Ecosystems

Call & Topic ID: Elevating the scalability potential of European business (2021) (HORIZON-EIE-2021-SCALEUP-01)

Deadline: November 10th 2021

Applicants: Women-led deep tech startups established in an EU Member State or a Horizon Europe Associated Country

Activity sector: deep tech

Partnership: not required

LIFE Programme: Circular Economy, resources from Waste, Air, Water, Soil, Noise, Chemicals, Bauhaus

The aim is to facilitate the transition toward a sustainable, circular, toxic-free, energy-efficient/climate-resilient economy and toward a toxic-free environment as well as to protect, restore and improve the quality of the environment. The specific objective is to cover one or more of the following topics as fully defined in section

2 of the Call document: Circular Economy and Waste; Air; Water; Soil; Noise, Chemicals; [A new European Bauhaus](#).

Funding programme: LIFE programme

Call & Topic ID: Circular Economy and Quality of Life - Standard Action Projects (SAP) (LIFE-2021-SAP-ENV)

Deadline: November 30th 2021

Applicants: legal entities established in different EU Member States or LIFE Programme associated countries

Activity sector: circular economy

Partnership: optional

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali calls for proposals.

W4RES first call for proposals

W4RES is looking for projects with a high level of women engagement that focus on the renewable heating and cooling sector. Such projects may include (but are not limited to) innovative technologies or design concepts for energy efficient buildings or city quarters, business ideas on how to engage people to reduce their carbon footprint or that sustainably address negative impacts of climate change.

Deadline: August 31st 2021

Applicants: women led projects/ideas

Activity sector: RHC (Renewable Heating and Cooling sector)

Partnership: not required

Open Call for Fusion Technology Transfer Demonstrator Proposals

This funding opportunity aims at supporting demonstrator projects where a fusion technology or know-how is planned to be used in a non-fusion environment. The applications will be evaluated according to three criteria: feasibility of the demonstrator project, its innovation potential and its socio-economic impact on the company and the ecosystem. A sole project will be selected and funded with 35,000€ (VAT exempt).

Deadline: October 15th 2021

Applicants: Any European companies and organisations presenting a project where a fusion technology or know-how is planned to be used in a non-fusion environment.

Activity sector: fusion technology

Partnership: not required

FORTHCOMING

Horizon Europe: Digital tools to support the engineering of a Circular Economy - Made in Europe Partnership (Research and Innovation Action)

The focus of this topic is on developing new concepts, methods, and digital tools to support further engineering of the industrial processes for recycling, re-manufacturing, refurbishing, and reuse of manufactured products and components. New solutions will enable remanufacturing and high-quality recycling by digitalisation of product and component information throughout the whole product lifecycle, in line with the 2020 Circular Economy Action Plan.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe, Cluster 4 – Digital, Industry and Space

Call & Topic ID: Climate neutral, circular and digitised production 2022 (HORIZON-CL4-2022-TWIN-TRANSITION-01-07)

Planned opening date: October 12th, 2021

Deadline: March 30th, 2022

Applicants: profit entities (Startups, SMEs, large companies); universities; public/private research centres; public administration; non-profit entities.

Activity sector: ICT

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)

Online, 24-25 novembre 2021

The Summit will attract high-growth European start-ups and innovators, in particular SMEs, researchers, corporates as well as potential investors and venture capitalists. It will provide a unique platform for all the participants to network and make business contacts.
