CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli <u>obiettivi politici</u> della Commissione per la programmazione 21-27. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **calls for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Horizon Europe: MSCA Choose Europe for Science 2025

The objective of MSCA Choose Europe for Science is to:

- increase the attractiveness of European research careers by addressing the issue of precarity offer excellent working conditions;
- turn the current challenge of brain drain in the research and innovation sector into brain gain.

The pilot action will support projects in which academic and non-academic organisations recruit postdoctoral researchers, with a view to offering longer-term employment beyond the project period. The main novelty of the initiative is that organisations will be selected also based on their offers of longer-term professional perspectives. Projects should recruit at least 3 researchers for up to 5 years, with MSCA co-funding the first 2 to 3 years and the institutions providing the funding (with internal or external funds) for an additional 2 years.

Horizon Europe: Federated CCAM data exchange platform (CCAM Partnership)

The call aims to establish a Federated CCAM Data Exchange Platform to facilitate seamless, secure, and sustainable data sharing for research, testing, and deployment of Connected, Cooperative and Automated Mobility (CCAM) solutions. Proposals should address the harmonisation of taxonomies, standards, and interfaces, mapping information and reference data needs for KPIs, and integrating existing and emerging dataspaces. The work should deliver governance models and viable business plans, and ensure interoperability with European data space initiatives, while enabling applications such as digital twins, safety validation, Al model training, and regulatory monitoring. The total budget allocated is €4 million.

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o "cascade funding" è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette "open calls". Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell'ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

AMALTEA Call #1

This call aims to develop innovative software or hardware solutions for facade applications, focusing on Al-enhanced design, digital twins, and robotics to drive sustainability and efficiency in construction. Projects must address one of the defined AMALTEA challenges and demonstrate TRL advancement (from TRL 3–5 to TRL 6–7). Selected participants will benefit from a 9 to 12 month support programme, including technical mentoring and business support. The total budget allocated is €1.500.000. Up to 25 projects will be selected, each receiving up to €100.000 for software solutions and up to €200.000 for hardware projects.

O-CEI Call #1

O-CEI aims to accelerate the adoption of Cloud-Edge-IoT solutions in the European Union. This call seeks upscaling projects that extend the functionalities of O-CEI pilots by testing components, developing edge solutions (apps and services), and providing added value. Applicants must address one specific challenge from an O-CEI pilot in sectors such as energy, automotive, and agrifood. Selected participants will benefit from a 7-month support programme. The total budget allocated is €2.4 million, with up to 24 projects to be selected, each receiving funding of up to €100.000.

FFplus: Second call for innovation studies for the development of generative Al models

This call aims at launching the second round of "innovation studies" specifically driven by the business needs of SMEs and start-ups with strong expertise in generative AI, professional software development, and data processing. Projects must leverage large-scale European HPC resources (such as pre-exascale and exascale supercomputers) to develop and customise generative AI models (including foundation models and large language models). Proposals should target concrete business-driven applications while also addressing innovation, scalability, and potential exploitation. The indicative total funding budget for all sub-projects funded under this call is € 4 million.
