CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli <u>obiettivi politici</u> della Commissione per la programmazione 21-27. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

European Partnership on Innovative SMEs / Innowwide call 2

The Innowwide programme helps innovative SMEs with the ambition to compete in new international markets by supporting market feasibility projects. A market feasibility project includes preliminary technical, market, legal and/or socioeconomic assessments intended to validate the feasibility of

international and innovative business solutions (product, process or service-market combination) within new and emerging global value chains. Call budget: 4.2 million euro to fund 70 projects. Each successful market feasibility project will receive a fixed grant of 60.000 euro.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe - European Partnership on the Innovative SMEs

Call & Topic ID: Innowwide call 2 - 2023

Deadline: October 17th 2023

Applicants: Innovative SMEs, including young companies and start-ups from any sector

Activity sectors: multiple

Partnership: required (each market feasibility project must include at least an applicant SME and an

independent subcontractor - local counterpart - in the target country).

Innovative Health Initiative (IHI) Joint Undertaking: 2023 calls for proposals

In the framework of 2023 work programme, the Innovative Health Initiative (IHI) has launched two new calls for proposals:

- <u>IHI call 4</u> is a two-stage call with topics on the 3Rs, patient-centric blood sample collection, clinical trials, and the environmental impacts of healthcare. The maximum financial contribution from IHI JU for these topics is 83.350.000 €;
- <u>IHI call 5</u> is a single-stage call with topics on the 3Rs, theragnostic, stroke management and synthetic data. The maximum financial contribution from IHI JU for these topics is 115 million €.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe - Innovative Health Initiative (IHI) Joint Undertaking *Call & Topic ID:* HORIZON-JU-IHI-2023-04-02-two-stage; HORIZON-JU-IHI-2023-05

Deadline: Call 4: 1st stage November 8th 2023 - 2nd stage April 23rd 2024 / Call 5: January 16th 2024

Applicants: legal entities established in EU Member States or HE associated countries

Activity sector: health

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)

Horizon Europe: Financial support for Ecosystem Partners

This coordination and support action aims to provide EIC awardees (including Seals of Excellence) with financial support to access services provided from ecosystem partners from Europe and beyond and meet their specific needs in terms of sectorial knowledge, networks, R&I infrastructure, access to markets or business development. The indicative budget of the call is EUR 4.5 million. Out of this amount approximately EUR 1.5 million will be allocated to services provided by EIT KICs. At least 75% (EUR 3.4 million) of the total budget to be funded by the EIC must be allocated to financial support to third parties (the EIC Awardees).

Funding programme: Horizon Europe - European Innovation Council

Call & Topic ID: Financial Support to access services from Ecosystem Partners (HORIZON-EIC-2023-PARTNERS-01)

Deadline: November 14th 2023

Applicants: legal entities from EU member states or HE associated countries; EIC Ecosystem Partners can include, for example, investors, business angels, mentors and coaches, innovation agencies, business associations, clusters, accelerators, incubators, technology transfer offices, etc.

Activity sector: business support

Partnership: not required (the project beneficiary can be a single legal entity or a consortium of legal

entities)

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o "cascade funding" è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette "open calls". Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell'ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

TrustChain 2nd Open Call

The EU-funded project TrustChain launched its second open call "User Privacy and Data Governance" with 1.989 million € for applications focusing on trustworthy online platforms that preserve user's data

privacy and provide strong data governance frameworks. Up to a maximum of 17 proposals will be

funded.

Deadline: September 20th 2023

Applicants: developers, innovators, researchers, SMEs and entrepreneurs established in EU Member

States or Horizon Europe associated countries

Activity sectors: data governance

Partnership: not required

XR2Learn 1st Open call

XR2Learn project (Leveraging the European XR industry technologies to empower immersive learning and training) is seeking applicant(s) to propose the development of novel applications along with specifications that combine XR and educational/training use cases. With respect to the targeted sectors, a minimum of 70% will be dedicated to XR-application relevant to industry 5.0 technologies and relevant skills and a maximum of 30% will be allocated to sub-projects targeting other educational sectors (e.g. healthcare and medical, manufacturing, construction and engineering). Funding range for sub-project between 150.000€-300.000€.

Deadline: September 29th 2023

Applicants: SMEs/Mid-caps from EU Member States or HE associated countries; academic or training

organizations may be included as potential user/early adopter

Activity sector: extended reality / training

Partnership: required (an application may be submitted by an individual SME or a small consortium of

up to 3 members in total. Coordinator must be an SME)

SUSTAIN Eurocluster: open call for innovation services in smart building construction

The SUSTAIN (cluSter bUilding SmarT reAdiness Indicators) open Call provides financial support to SMEs for developing new products, services or methods addressing the smart building construction challenges. Total funding available: 600.000€. Maximum budget per proposal: 50.000€.

Planned opening date: September 1st 2023

Deadline: November 1st 2023

Applicants: SMEs from EU Member States or Single Market Programme associated countries

Activity sector: building construction

Partnership: optional (SMEs can apply individually or as consortium)
