CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli <u>obiettivi politici</u> della Commissione per la programmazione 21-27. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Connecting Europe Facility: 2023 Digital Calls for proposals

The third calls for proposals under the digital strand of the Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) programme cover the following areas:

- <u>5G coverage along transport corridors</u> (roads, rail, waterways) with €100 million for studies and works
- 5G and Edge Cloud for Smart Communities with €51 million for works.

• <u>Backbone connectivity for Digital Global Gateways</u> (submarine cables, satellite ground infrastructure) with €90 million for studies and works.

HaDEA will co-fund projects of common European interest from €51 to €100 million depending on the call topic.

Connecting Europe Facility: 2023 Transport Calls for proposals

The 2023 CEF Transport calls for proposals make EUR 7 billion available for projects targeting new and improved European transport infrastructure, supporting the European Commission's vision of a future sustainable transport system, with smart and resilient solutions implemented to interconnect Europe. The calls cover the Core and Comprehensive TEN-T networks in the following areas: railways; inland waterways; maritime and inland ports; road safety; rail-road terminals; multimodal logistics platforms; multimodal passenger hubs; smart and interoperable applications for transport; safe and secure mobility; infrastructure resilience.

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o "cascade funding" è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette "open calls". Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell'ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

WORTH II 3rd call for projects

Funded by COSME Programme, WORTH is aimed at creating and supporting transnational partnerships between designers, crafters, SME manufacturers, tech-firms and start-ups looking to develop design-driven and innovative products. The project focuses on lifestyle industries, including fashion and textile, footwear, leather and furniture/home decoration/interior design, jewellery and accessories. Selected project will benefit from an incubator programme including €10.000 to €20.000 seed money.

Deadline: November 27th 2023

Applicants: designers, crafters, SME manufacturers, tech-firms and start-ups located in the EU, UK or COSME associated countries

Activity sector: lifestyle industries (fashion and textile, footwear, leather and furniture/home decoration/interior design, jewellery and accessories)

EIT Manufacturing Accelerate 2023 Call

The EIT Manufacturing Accelerate programme has a primary objective to support, scale and accelerate industry startups into impactful players in the European manufacturing ecosystem. Accelerate programme supports and grants financing to startups with innovative product/service that address at least one of the four EIT Manufacturing focus areas (flagships), helping the European manufacturing sector become more efficient, resilient, green, and globally competitive. The total maximum EIT funding allocated to this call is 4.000.000 €. The available financial support (also known as "sub-grant") is up to 500.000 € per company.

Deadline: December 1st 2023

Applicants: startups established in the Member States (MS) of the European Union (EU), and/or in third

countries associated to Horizon Europe with at least 2 team members.

Activity sectors: manufacturing sector

Partnership: not required

EPICENTRE Eurocluster 2nd Open Call

EPICENTRE aims to support SMEs and start-ups in the development of innovative solutions in collaborations with corporates that make a significant impact in the sectors and value chains they belong to. SMEs and start-ups are invited to solve a set of challenges provided by corporates from the Health, Agrifood and Digital-Fintech sectors. The applications selected, will enter the EPICENTRE Acceleration program, enrol in the EPICENTRE Academy and receive up to 49.000€ lump sum financial contribution.

Deadline: December 5th 2023

Applicants: SMEs and start-ups from SMP or associated countries

Activity sectors: Health, Agrifood and Digital-Fintech

Partnership: optional (proposals can be submitted individually or jointly by 2-3 SMEs maximum)

Cross-border renewable energy projects shall promote cross-border cooperation between Member States in the field of planning, development and the cost-effective exploitation of renewable energy sources, as well as facilitate their integration through energy storage facilities and with the aim of contributing to the Union's long-term decarbonisation strategy, completing the internal energy market and enhancing the security of supply. Call budget: 50 million €.
