CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 21-27. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche **call for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

European Defence Fund: Non-thematic development actions by SMEs

This call encourages the driving role of innovative SMEs to turn technology and research results into defence products in a fast and cost-efficient way, possibly by adapting technologies from civil applications or addressing hybrid warfare. Successful SME beneficiaries may be offered Business Coaching, to reduce the time of bringing the results to the next phase of development.

Funding programme: European Defence Fund

Call & Topic ID: Development actions through lump sum grants following the call for proposals (EDF-2022-LS-DA-SME)

Deadline: November 24th 2022

Applicants: SMEs

Activity sector: defence / dual use technologies

Horizon Europe: Improved monitoring of threats, intrusion detection and response in complex and heterogeneous digital systems and infrastructures

Proposals should develop and validate demonstration prototypes of tools and technologies to monitor and analyse cybersecurity incidents in an operational environment in line with the NIS directive and the General Data Protection Regulation. They should contribute to improved penetration testing methods and their automation by using machine learning and other AI technologies as appropriate.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe - Cluster 3: Civil Security for Society

Call & Topic ID: Increased cybersecurity 2022 (HORIZON-CL3-2022-CS-01-01)

Deadline: November 16th 2022

Applicants: legal entities (public or private bodies) established in EU Member States or associated countries

Activity sectors: cybersecurity

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o “cascade funding” è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette “open calls”. Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals.

Change2Twin 2nd Assessment Voucher Open Call

Change2Twin is a European project which supports manufacturing SMEs in their digitalization process by providing Digital Twin solutions. Up to 30 manufacturing SMEs and MidCaps will be selected to receive a detailed analysis of their situation and 3 different “recipes” from a certified Digital Innovation Hub which they choose to work with, containing the list of different technologies fitting the use case and details of an integrator willing to implement them. Up to 30 beneficiaries will receive up to 10.000 euro as a lump sum.

Applicants: end-user manufacturing SMEs and MidCaps

Activity sector: digital technologies

Partnership: not required

IoT-NGIN – Open Call #2

The objective of the IoT-NGIN – Open Call #2 is to validate the IoT-NGIN components/technology by EU based SMEs active in IoT applications' development. The open call will have three phases: DESIGN (where 10 proposals will be selected), EXPERIMENT (where the 6 top projects from the DESIGN phase will enter this phase), GROWTH (where the 3 top projects from the EXPERIMENT phase will enter). The total amount of funding that each SME may receive is up to €70.000, while the top#1 SME will receive in total €75.000.

Deadline: September 30th 2022

Applicants: SMEs / start-ups

Activity sector: IoT applications development

Partnership: not required

KYKLOS 4.0 - Open Call #2

The objective of the KYKLOS4.0 – Open Call #2 is to accelerate innovation in the digital manufacturing domain by facilitating the implementation of projects led by SMEs and with the participation of an industrial partner. The objective of the open call is funding the development of innovative solutions to improve digital manufacturing processes. The maximum amount of funding per awarded project is €150.000.

Deadline: October 12th 2022

Applicants: SMEs / start-ups

Activity sector: digital manufacturing

Partnership: required (consortia of 2-3 entities, led by an SME)

Lump Sum Funding in Horizon Europe: How does it work? How to write a proposal?

Online, October 20th 2022

Horizon Europe uses lump sum funding to reduce administration and financial errors. Lump sums make the programme simpler by removing the need to report actual costs, making access to the programme easier for small organisations and newcomers, who often lack the experience and capacity to cope with the complex rules for actual costs. The European Commission is organising a webinar to present lump-sum funding in Horizon Europe, including presentation of practical experience with lump sum grants.
