CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli obiettivi politici della Commissione per la programmazione 21-27. Tali programmi prevedono specifiche call for proposals pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e

anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Horizon Europe: Al for human empowerment (Al, Data and Robotics Partnership) (RIA)

The scope of this action is to build the next level of perception, visualisation, interaction and collaboration between humans and AI systems. Innovative and promising approaches are encouraged, including human-in the loop approaches for truly mixed human-AI initiatives combining the best of human and machine knowledge and capabilities, tacit knowledge extraction (to design the next generation AI-driven co-creation and collaboration tools embodied e.g. in industrial/working spaces environments).

Connecting Europe Facility: 2022 CEF Digital Call

The second set of calls under the Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) Digital Programme is open for submission of proposals, with a total budget of 277 M€. The aim is to support projects for secure, fast and high-capacity networks, backbone infrastructures, including quantum communication, cloud federation and submarine cables, strengthen the networks that connect rural, remote and overseas areas, as well as increasingly digitalise transport and energy networks.

Call for Solutions: Metaverse Learning Camp 22

This international call for solutions aims to facilitate open innovation as well as networking between the supply and demand for 30 companies that will be selected to share their know-how with educators and innovators from training and learning institutions. Target companies are companies and SMEs working on XR innovations that are fostering people's engagement in the Metaverse or integrating XR in the upskilling and reskilling. The 30 selected companies will be invited to exhibit their innovations during the Metaverse Learning Camp 22 and freely attend dedicated pitching sessions where they will meet big industry and international organizations involved in international human capital development like the ITCILO and ETF, as well as venture capitalists and investors.

Deadline: October 31st 2022 **Applicants:** companies/SMEs

Activity sectors: Sustainable mobility (including the automotive sector); Aerospace/Aeronautical industry; Agro-processing/Agricultural industry; Content industry (cinema, music, publishing, gaming, eSports, etc.).

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o "cascade funding" è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette "open calls". Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali call for proposals. Nella presente sezione sono riportate anche le call pubblicate nell'ambito delle KICs (Knowledge and Innovation Communities) dello European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT).

StairwAl 2nd open call

StairwAI is an EU-funded project targeting SMEs working in low-tech sectors that do not have immediate access nor knowledge on AI techniques, matching them with cloud providers and AI experts. StairwAI will select 14 low-tech SMEs to perform a feasibility study and pilot for the adoption of AI. Applicants have to focus on addressing one of the challenge areas using a set of AI tools and resources that will be available on the AI4EU platform. Financial support up to €60.000 per SME, including vouchers.

BD4NRG Open Call

BD4NRG Open Call is looking for up to 10 SMEs/Start-ups that will introduce new services by integrating and making use of the services and data offered through the BD4NRG platform. Applicants are asked to submit proposals under one of the following 4 topics with the initiative to promote the development of new tools, services, and activities: Efficiency and reliability of electricity networks operation improvement; Optimisation of grid and distributed assets; Energy efficiency investments planning; Cross-Cutting Applications. Financial support up to €60.000 per SME.
