europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Joint Cluster Initiatives (EUROCLUSTERS) for Europe's recovery

The Euroclusters will contribute to the implementation of the European Commission's New Industrial Strategy for Europe, as well as its updated Strategy that was published in May 2021 and the SME Strategy for a sustainable and digital Europe adopted in March 2020, by building resilience and accelerating transition to green and digital economy.

Funding programme: Single Market Programme

Call & Topic ID: Joint Cluster Initiatives (EUROCLUSTERS) for Europe's recovery (SMP-COSME-2021-

CLUSTER)

Deadline: November 30th, 2021

Applicants: cluster organisations and cluster networks or other types of organisations supporting green and digital transitions and building EU resilience

Activity sector: multiple

Partnership: required (minimum 3 cluster organisations or cluster networks from at least 3 different EU

Member States).

Innovation Fund Large Scale Projects

The present call targets projects on low-carbon technologies and processes in all sectors covered by Directive 2003/87/EC (the EU ETS Directive). Innovation in low-carbon technologies and processes in sectors listed in Annex I, including environmentally safe carbon capture and utilisation ('CCU') that contributes substantially to mitigating climate change, as well as products substituting carbon intensive ones produced in sectors listed in Annex I, environmentally safe capture and geological storage ('CCS') of CO2, and innovative renewable energy and energy storage technologies.

Funding programme: Innovation Fund

Call & Topic ID: Innovation Fund Large Scale Projects (InnovFund-LSC-2021)

Deadline: March 3rd, 2022

Applicants: legal entities (either private or public), international organisations.

Activity sector: multiple

Partnership: not required (the minimum number of applicants is one, but applications may also be submitted

by a consortium of legal entities acting together)

Circular and low emission value chains through digitalisation - Processes4Planet Partnership (RIA)

While circularity is in simple terms addressed by waste from one process becoming secondary materials for others, an efficient use in the value chain in order to close the loop or reuse in other industries can be ensured only through a transparent information system. Projects are therefore expected to contribute to the following outcomes: a) demonstrate an increase in the waste reduction by application of digital technologies; b) demonstrate optimisation of use of secondary raw materials in the value chains.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe - Cluster 4: Digital, Industry and Space

Call & Topic ID: A digitised, resource-efficient and resilient industry 2022 (HORIZON-CL4-2022-RESILIENCE-01-01)

Deadline: March 30th, 2022

Applicants: profit entities (Startups, SMEs, large companies); universities; public/private research centres; public administration; non-profit entities

Activity sector: digital technologies for waste reduction

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o "cascade funding" è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette "open calls". Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un

finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali calls for proposals.

DAPSI 3rd open calls

DAPSI, the Data Portability and Services Incubator, is a European project funded by the European Commission

to empower top internet innovators to develop human-centric technology solutions addressing the challenge of personal data portability on the internet as foreseen under the GDPR. This 3rd Open Call allocates €2.5M to fund third parties such as researchers, SMEs and entrepreneurs among others, to conduct advanced research applied to Data Portability use cases.

Deadline: November 23rd 2021

Applicants: Either natural persons or legal entities (SMEs, entrepreneurs, researchers ...)

Activity sector: ICT Partnership: not required

PLATOON 2nd open call

Platoon project is calling for SMEs to digitise the energy sector, having experience in and targeting services/products in at least one of the below experimentation areas: Digital Interoperability (APIs and Data models); Data governance, security, privacy and sovereignty; Data Analytics applications in energy (e.g. Predictive maintenance, Demand forecast etc.); Edge computing (SW/HW). Selected projects will receive up to 150.000€ funding, including business and technical support during a 9-month Support Programme.

FORTHCOMING

Digital Europe Programme calls on sectorial Testing and Experimentation Facilities (TEFs)

Under the Digital Europe Programme (DIGITAL), the European Commission expects to open calls for proposals to fund AI Testing and Experimentation Facilities (TEFs) in February 2022. These TEFs will be in the sectors of agri-food (€30 million), healthcare (€30 million), manufacturing (€30 million) as well as smart cities and communities (€20). These calls will be co-funded equally at EU and Member States level. The European Commission foresees one large-scale project of €40 - €60 million overall funding per sector, each of them requiring a consortium of several testing facilities across Europe.
