CALLS FOR PROPOSALS

Attraverso i programmi europei a gestione diretta, l'UE sostiene finanziariamente lo sviluppo di progetti che contribuiscono a realizzare gli <u>obiettivi politici</u> della Commissione per la programmazione 21-27. Tali

programmi prevedono specifiche **calls for proposals** pubblicate e gestite direttamente dalla Commissione europea e dalle sue Agenzie esecutive. Ciascun programma può prevedere regole di candidatura distinte e anche le modalità di gestione e rendicontazione delle attività realizzate e delle relative spese possono essere diverse.

Horizon Europe: Sustainable biodegradable novel bio-based plastics: innovation for sustainability and end-of-life options of plastics (Innovation Action)

There is a need to develop innovative, sustainable bio-based and biodegradable plastics with novel properties and production processes to deliver environmentally friendly materials with the desired properties for longterm circular applications, markets and uses. The approach should combine environmental sustainability, circularity and functionality of the developed products and of the supply chain. Results should be aligned to recent policy developments on plastics.

Funding programme: Horizon Europe, Cluster 6 – Food, Bioeconomy, Natural Resources, Agriculture *Call & Topic ID:* Circular economy and bioeconomy sectors (HORIZON-CL6-2022-CIRCBIO-02-03-two-stage)

Deadline: (Two-stage) February 15th 2022 / September 1st 2022

Applicants: profit entities (Startups, SMEs, large companies); universities; public/private research centres; public administration; non-profit entities

Activity sector: bio-based materials (plastics)

Partnership: required (at least 3 independent legal entities established in different EU Member States or Horizon Europe associated countries)

Single Market Programme: COVID-19 Recovery Through Sustainable Tourism Growth and SME Support

The action aims to support tourism SMEs in developing their skills and capacities in sustainable tourism; to provide capacity building, value chain insights and technical assistance to SMEs; to develop a monitoring framework which regularly collects and makes available data on the sustainability performance of the SMEs; to foster innovative solutions for sustainable tourism; and to build effective mechanisms for best practice exchange and dissemination of transferable tools and knowledge between the SMEs, also at a European level.

Funding programme: Single Market Programme (SMP)

Call & Topic ID: COVID-19 Recovery Through Sustainable Tourism Growth and SME Support (SMP-COSME-2021-TOURSME-01)

Deadline: February 16th 2022

Applicants: legal entities (public or private bodies) established in EU member states or SMP associated countries.

Partnership: proposals must be submitted by a trans-national consortium, which complies with the following conditions: a) minimum 5 and a maximum of 8 entities (excluding affiliated entities) from 5 different eligible countries; minimum 1 business support organisation (BSO); b) minimum 1 destination management organisation (DMO) involved in and dealing with sustainability as applied to the tourism sector. **More info:** scheda di approfondimento disponibile nell'<u>area riservata Confindustria EU</u>

Horizon Europe: Smart and multifunctional biomaterials for health innovations (Research and Innovation Action)

Projects are expected to contribute to the following outcomes: a) Offer solutions through the development of multifunctional biomaterials to address and mitigate multiple bottlenecks in response to unmet clinical needs; b) Provide improved biocompatibility, biospecificity and longevity of medical devices or if relevant, improved bioactivity and/or biodegradability; physiological and biomechanical constraints and implications should also be considered; c) Show that the regulatory and IPR strategies are compatible with the overall research objectives.

Deadline: March 30th 2022

With an estimated budget of €26.2 billion, it offers mobility and cooperation opportunities in higher education, vocational education and training, school education (including early childhood education and care), adult education, youth

CASCADE FUNDING

Il supporto finanziario a parti terze o "cascade funding" è un meccanismo di finanziamento della Commissione europea attraverso cui il consorzio beneficiario è incaricato di distribuire sovvenzioni ad entità terze attraverso le cosiddette "open calls". Accedere a una sovvenzione derivante da una open call consente di ricevere un finanziamento pubblico per eseguire specifiche attività di ricerca e innovazione (studi, esperimenti, azioni pilota) senza dover incorrere negli oneri burocratici delle tradizionali calls for proposals.

EIT Urban Mobility: Call for Proposals for #ChallengeMyCity

The #ChallengeMyCity call provides innovative mobility solutions with the opportunity to perform a pilot in a city's urban environment in real conditions. For the first release of this call, the cities of Toulouse and Milan are participating. They present specific mobility challenges that need to be addressed and will be hosting the pilots to tackle these challenges:

- Challenge A (Toulouse): Up to 60,000 EUR
- Challenge B (Milan): Up to 60,000 EUR
- Challenge C (Milan): Up to 30,000 EUR
- Deadline: February 8th 2022

Applicants: entities (both EIT Urban Mobility and non-EIT Urban Mobility partners) coming from industry and located in an EU country or a Third country associated to Horizon Europe.

Activity sector: mobility

Partnership: not required

Horizon Europe: EU Missions calls for proposals

EU Missions are a novelty of the Horizon Europe research and innovation programme for 2021-2027 aiming to address some of the greatest challenges facing our society. With this <u>work programme</u>, the Commission launches the first fully-fledged research and innovation actions that will launch missions into the implementation stage. The Commission invites researchers and innovators as well as citizens and all interested stakeholders to take part in the five missions:

- <u>Adaptation to Climate Change: support at least 150 European regions and communities to become climate resilient by 2030</u>
- <u>Cancer: improving the lives of more than 3 million people by 2030 through prevention, cure and for</u>
 <u>those affected by cancer including their families, to live longer and better</u>

- <u>Restore our Ocean and Waters by 2030</u>
- <u>100 Climate-Neutral and Smart Cities by 2030</u>
- <u>A Soil Deal for Europe: 100 living labs and lighthouses to lead the transition towards healthy soils</u>
 <u>by 2030</u>

Funding programme: Horizon Europe

Planned opening dates: The first round of these calls will open on 22 December 2021 and the second will open on 11 January 2022.
